How Much Do Bankruptcy Lawyers Charge for Chapter 7? Our survey showed that on average, readers paid their lawyers \$1,450 to file for Chapter 7 bankruptcy. Four in ten (40%) paid between \$1,000 and \$1,500, while some paid as little as \$500 or as much as \$5,000. More than three quarters (78%) of readers paid their Chapter 7 lawyers \$1,500 or less.

As of November 2012, the cost for filing a Chapter 7 case in any U.S. Bankruptcy Court was set at \$306. You must pay the filing fee, regardless of where in the country you file your case or how much income you earn. If necessary, you can ask to pay the filing fee in installments.

For a Chapter 7 case, the fee is \$335. For a Chapter 13 case, the fee is \$310. The Bankruptcy Trustee may charge a fee of \$15 to \$20 when you file, as well. You may request to pay the filing fees in installments; most courts will allow it if you can show it would be a financial hardship to pay all at once.

A fee is charged for converting, on request of the debtor, a case under chapter 7 to a case under chapter 11. The fee charged is the difference between the filing fee for a chapter 7 and the filing fee for a chapter 11. 28 U.S.C. § 1930 (a). Currently, the difference is \$922.

This includes a \$245 case filing fee, a miscellaneous administrative fee of \$46 and a trustee surcharge of \$15.
