The Missa brevis in D minor, K. 65/61a, is a mass composed by Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart (12 years old at the time) and completed on 14 January 1769. It is scored for SATB soloists and choir, violin I and II, 3 trombones colla parte, and basso continuo.

The "Missa brevis in d minor" is one of the few masses Mozart composed in minor. Only in two other masses did Mozart choose a minor mode - the "Missa solemnis" (K. 139) and the "Grosse Messe" (K. 427).

Antonio Lotti: Missa brevis in F, Missa brevis in D Minor (Kyrie - Sanctus & Benedictus - Agnus Dei settings) The three Choral-Messen (Windhaager Messe , Kronstorfer Messe and Messe für den Gründonnerstag), all partial settings which Bruckner composed between 1842 and 1844, were intended for the celebration of the mass in the villages Windhaag and Kronstorf , where he was schoolteacher's assistant.

Description. During the summer of 1774 Mozart wrote two Masses within a few weeks: the Missa brevis in F major, K. 192, and the Missa brevis in D major, K. 194. A feature common to both compositions as well as to the Dixit et Magnificat K. 193, written at about the same time, and the "Trinitas" Mass K. 167 of the previous year, is a more or less strongly evident tendency towards contrapuntal writing.

The Missa brevis in G major, K. 140, K 3 Anh. 235d, K 6 Anh. C 1.12, was probably composed by Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart shortly after returning to Salzburg, in March 1773, from his third trip to Italy.. Walter Senn, who published the Mass in 1968 for the Neue Mozart-Ausgabe, notes that this Mass is the only one Mozart composed along the lines of the Pastoral Mass type.

Salzburg Cathedral may have been the first performance venue of the mass. The Missa brevis No. 9 in B-flat major by Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart, K. 275/272b, was probably written before September 1777 for Salzburg.

The mass is scored for SATB soloists, SATB choir, violin I, violin II, 3 trombones, string bass, and organ .
